**NOTE 1: Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

---

---

**Entity**

---

The Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas is an agency of the state of Texas and its financial records comply with state statutes and regulations. This includes compliance with the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts' *Reporting Requirements for Annual Financial Reports of State Agencies and Universities*.

The Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas is the state agency mandated to (1) create and expedite innovation in the area of cancer research and in enhancing the potential for a medical or scientific breakthrough in the prevention of cancer and cures for cancer; (2) attract, create, or expand research capabilities of public or private institutions of higher education and other public or private entities that will promote a substantial increase in cancer research and in the creation of high-quality new jobs in this state; and (3) develop and implement the Texas Cancer Plan.

Due to the statewide requirements embedded in GASB Statement No. 34, *Basic Financial Statements – and Management's Discussion and Analysis – for State and Local Governments*, the Comptroller of Public Accounts does not require the accompanying annual financial report to comply with all of the requirements in this statement. The financial report will be considered for audit by the State Auditor as part of the audit of the state of Texas *Comprehensive Annual Financial Report* (CAFR); therefore, an opinion has not been expressed on the financial statements and related information contained in this report.

**Blended Component Units**

---

No component units have been identified which should have been blended into an appropriate fund.

---

**Fund Structure**

---

The accompanying financial statements are presented on the basis of funds, each of which is considered a separate accounting entity.

---

**Governmental Fund Types and Government-wide Adjustment Fund Types**

---

**General Revenue Funds**

Cancer Prevention and Research Fund (appropriated fund 5136) – The fund receives fees charged by the agency for product development research grant application submissions and all miscellaneous agency revenues.

License Plate Trust Fund (appropriated fund 0802) – The fund receives fee revenue from the sale of cancer specialty license plates. This fee is collected by the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles for a discretionary purchase of a specialty license plate in addition to standard motor vehicle registration fees.

Interest and Sinking Fund (fund 5168) - The fund receives payments from CPRIT grantees according to the agency's grant revenue sharing agreements for licensing, royalty or equity revenue. Revenue collected in this fund may only be appropriated by the Texas Legislature to pay debt service on CPRIT's general obligation bonds.



### **Capital Project Fund**

The TPFA General Obligation Commercial Paper Cancer Project (appropriated fund 7639) is used to account for general obligation bond proceeds issued by the Texas Public Finance Authority. The bond proceeds support the agency's operating expenses and cancer prevention and research grants awarded to organizations in Texas.

### **Capital Assets Adjustment Fund Type**

The capital assets adjustment fund (fund 0998) is used to convert governmental fund types' capital assets from modified accrual to full accrual.

### **Long-Term Liabilities Adjustment Fund Type**

The long-term liabilities adjustment fund (fund 0997) is used to convert governmental fund types' debt from modified accrual to full accrual

## **Basis of Accounting**

---

The basis of accounting determines when revenues and expenditures or expenses are recognized in the accounts reported in the financial statements. The accounting and financial reporting treatment applied to a fund is determined by its measurement focus.

Governmental fund types are accounted for using the modified accrual basis of accounting. Under the modified accrual basis, revenues are recognized in the period in which they become both measurable and available to finance operations during the fiscal year or liquidate liabilities existing at fiscal year-end.

The state of Texas considers receivables collected within 60 days after fiscal year-end to be available and recognizes them as revenues of the current year for fund financial statements prepared on the modified accrual basis. Expenditures and other uses of financial resources are recognized when the related liability is incurred.

Basis conversion adjustment fund types convert modified accrued basis to full accrued basis of accounting. The following activities are recognized in these fund types:

- Capital assets
- Accumulated depreciation
- Unpaid employee compensable leave
- The outstanding debt service principal and interest on long-term liabilities
- Capital leases
- Long-term claims and judgments
- Full accrual revenues and expenses
- Pension amounts in governmental activities.

## **Budget and Budgetary Accounting**

---

The budget is prepared biennially and represents appropriations authorized by the Texas Legislature and approved by the governor (the General Appropriations Act).

Unencumbered appropriations are generally subject to lapse 60 days after fiscal year-end for which they were appropriated.

## Assets, Liabilities, and Fund Balances/Net Position

---

### Assets

---

#### Inventories and Prepaid Items

Inventories include both merchandise inventories on hand for sale and consumable inventories. Inventories are valued at cost, generally using the last-in, first-out method. The consumption method of accounting is used to account for inventories and prepaid items that appear in the governmental fund type. The cost of these items is expensed when the items are used or consumed.

#### Capital Assets

Assets that meet the reporting threshold and useful life are capitalized. The capitalization threshold and the estimated useful life vary depending on the asset type. These assets are capitalized at cost or, if purchased, at appraisal fair value as of the date of acquisition. Purchases of assets by governmental funds are reported as expenditures. Depreciation is reported on all "exhaustible" assets. "Inexhaustible" assets (such as works of art and historical treasures) are not depreciated. Other depreciable assets are depreciated over the estimated useful life of the asset using the straight-line method.

### Liabilities

---

#### Accounts Payable

Accounts payable represents the liability for the value of assets or services received at the balance sheet date for which payment is pending.

#### Employees' Compensable Leave Balances

Employees' compensable leave balances represent the liability that becomes "due" upon the occurrence of relevant events such as resignations, retirements, and uses of leave balances by covered employees. Liabilities are reported separately as either current or noncurrent in the statement of net position. These obligations are normally paid from the same funding source from which each employee's salary or wage compensation was paid.

### Fund Balance/Net Position

---

"Fund balance" is the difference between assets plus deferred outflows of resources and liabilities plus deferred inflows of resources on the governmental fund statements. "Net position" is the difference between assets plus deferred outflows of resources and liabilities plus deferred inflows of resources on the government-wide fund statements.

#### Fund Balance Components

Fund balances for governmental funds are classified as nonspendable, restricted, committed, assigned or unassigned in the fund financial statements.

- **Nonspendable fund balance** includes amounts not available to be spent because they are either:
  - Not in spendable form or
  - Legally or contractually required to be maintained intact.

- **Restricted fund balance** includes those resources that have constraints placed on their use through external parties such as creditors, grantors, contributors, laws or regulations of other governments or by law through constitutional provisions or enabling legislation.
- **Committed fund balance** can be used only for specific purposes pursuant to constraints imposed through legislation passed into law by a formal action of the Texas Legislature, the state's highest level of decision making authority.
- **Assigned fund balance** includes amounts constrained by the state's intent to be used for specific purposes, but the constraints do not meet the requirements to be reported as restricted or committed. Intent is expressed by either:
  - The Texas Legislature or
  - A body (for example, a budget or finance committee) or official to which the governing body has delegated the authority to assign amounts to be used for specific purposes.
- **Unassigned fund balance** is the residual classification for the general fund. This classification represents fund balance that was not restricted, committed or assigned to specific purposes within the general fund.

**Employees' Compensable Leave**

If a state employee had continuous employment with the state for at least six months, the state employee is entitled to be paid for all unused vacation time accrued in the event of the employee's resignation, dismissal, or separation from state employment.

Expenditures for accumulated annual leave balances are recognized in the period paid or taken in governmental fund types. For these fund types, the liability for unpaid benefits is recorded in the statement of net position. Both an expense and a liability for business-type activities are recorded in the proprietary funds as the benefits accrue to employees. No liability is recorded for non-vesting employees accumulating rights to receive sick pay benefits. This obligation is usually paid from the same funding source(s) from which the employee's salary or wage compensation is paid.
