#### **REVENUE ASSUMPTIONS:**

For the product development research program, CPRIT requires that applicants pay a fee of either \$500 or \$1000 based on the type of grant mechanism application to ensure that the applications are not frivolous and do defray some of the additional cost associated with evaluation of these applications. The product development research grant application evaluation is composed of not only peer review but also business, regulatory and intellectual property due diligence which results in a additional expense not necessary for academic research or prevention grant application evaluations. The fees were estimated to generate approximately \$40,000 per year in third-party reimbursements; however, the product development research grant application process has changed so the fee revenue will no longer be at that level.

The registration fee revenue collected for CPRIT's 2023 Innovations VI Conference held on October 2-3, 2023, will be used to pay for conference food and beverage catering, audio visual, printing and other related expenses.

For the payment of conference registration fees, CPRIT utilized DIR's Texas.gov credit card processing services and those transaction expenses are reflected in the revenue and deductions.
