# REAL MOMENTUM **IND** MEASURABLE RESULTS

The Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas was created in 2007 when Texans voted to invest \$3 billion in a historic fight against cancer. Texas voters continued their support in 2019, when they overwhelmingly approved a constitutional amendment to provide an additional \$3 billion, making CPRIT a \$6 billion, 20-year initiative.

CPRIT awards grants for a wide variety of innovative cancer-related research, prevention and product development projects. **Metroplex-area benefits include:** 

#### Investing in the research capabilities of Metroplex-area research entities

- \$609 million in grants awarded to 9 Metroplex-area research entities
- ► 98 stellar researchers and their labs recruited to Metroplex-area research entities
- ► \$650 million in direct follow-on funding raised by Metroplex-area CPRIT grantees
- ► UT Southwestern Medical Center achieved NCI comprehensive cancer center status

► 10 CPRIT core facility awards and renewals in the Metroplex area to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through specialized instrumentation and technical expertise

#### Expand life science infrastructure by attracting companies to the Metroplex & creating high-quality jobs

► 10 companies started, expanded, or brought to the Metroplex with CPRIT investment totaling \$95 million

► 13 CPRIT-funded companies have established connections to Metroplex-area academic institutions

- ▶ \$1.21 billion total expenditures statewide in 2022
- ▶ \$49.4 million annual state and local tax collections
- ► \$2.17 billion direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT companies in the Metroplex
- ▶ Over 7,840 permanent jobs created in 2022 in Texas

#### Expedite innovation breakthroughs in prevention and cures

► 4,652 patients in 52 clinical trials or studies in the Metroplex

► \$355 million in grants awarded for 291 prevention projects in all 254 Texas counties

► 35,374 cancer precursors and 5,166 cancers detected in Texas

Follow-on Funding Success

CPRIT-funded academic research grantees and companies in the Metroplex raised \$2.82 billion in follow-on funds, exceeding contracted awards by \$2.11 billion


- ► Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers in Texas
- 12 percent of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer projects – proportionately 3 times more than national commitment
